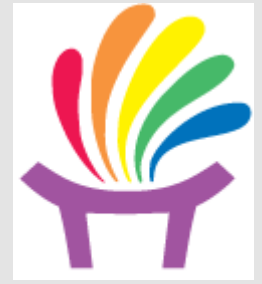

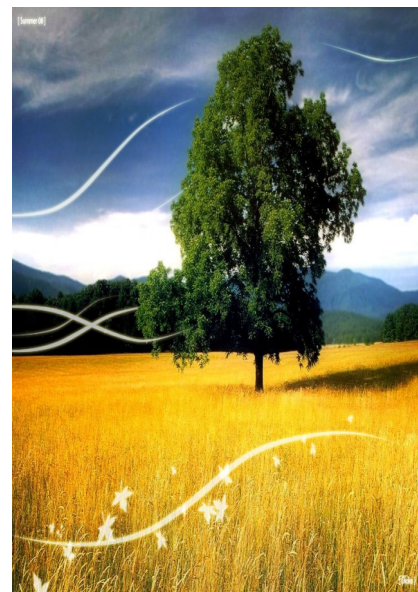

### **Recruitment of members to a Legacy Fund Program Committee.**

The Board has passed the terms of reference for the Legacy Fund Program Giving Policy. These are also our congregation's marching orders for setting up our two funds, the Legacy Fund and the Opportunity Fund. As part of the policy, the Board has directed that a subcommittee of the Finance committee be established to carry out the work of the Legacy Fund program. This is a call for volunteers to serve as the inaugural members of this important committee. We will recruit up to six members. Hopefully, the membership will reflect the diversity of the congregation. No experience in accounting or finance is required; just good common sense. Once the initial set up period is over, the committee members will have three-year terms that will be staggered such that one or two members' terms will be completed every year. Members can renew for a second three-year term and then must take one three-year term off after which they can be re-appointed. The workload will not be onerous. There may be monthly meetings initially to set up the funds and working policies, but after that the committee will need to meet only three or four times per year or the call of the chair.
